Youth Group First Official Fall Meeting, Sunday, September 11, 6 – 8 p.m.

All youth in the 6th through 12th grades are invited to come to one of the most exciting groups at St. Michael's- Youth Group!!! Youth group isn't a repeat of Sunday morning formation (i.e. Sunday School) classes. Youth group is a place where we come together in fellowship as a community of faith to have fun, to do service projects both outside and inside the church, to discover a little bit more about ourselves and our place in the world, to learn to see God working in our daily lives and in those around us, and to have a safe place to pose difficult questions and discuss difficult topics.

At our first meeting we will come up with ideas of activities and service projects for the coming year through next May. Our goal is to have one service project every month. Youth group will meet 90% of the time on Sunday evenings from 6- 8 p.m. in the youth room; however, certain service projects or activities can occur outside that time frame. Every effort will be given to keep youth members and their parents apprised of those changes.

We had a fantastic group of leaders for our youth group last year and they will all be returning! Youth leaders for the coming year are Deacon Laura Blazek, Melissa Gray, Susie Walker and James Cassidy. Parents can contact anyone of the leaders with questions or concerns.

Fall Sunday School Kicks Off September 11

While the adult formation class continued to meet, the children and youth took a break during the summer. Parents, children and youth it is time to get fired up about an exciting formation year starting the first Sunday after Labor Day!!!

We are using a new curriculum this year for both the children and youth called Weaving God's Promises. This program was created for Episcopal children and youth, helping them learn to weave scripture and tradition into their lives, helping them to discover that they are part of this great story, not just bystanders watching it all unfold. At this time all children from 3 years old through 5th grade will meet as one class. This program is designed in such a way that age appropriate games, crafts, ideas, and reasoning can be done by then dividing into smaller groups as needed. Should we find that we have enough kids to accommodate two classes, we will then permanently divide into two separate classes. This class will meet in the largest room in the education building next to the Sunday school supply closet. Signs will be posted on the doors. Teachers for this class are Randy Witzke and Melissa Gray.

The youth, 6th grade through 12th grade, will use Weaving God's Promises for youth. This group will meet in the youth room. Just as with the children, the youth will discover how to weave scripture and tradition into their lives as they are growing up and finding their way in the world. Deacon Laura Blazek will be leading this class.

The adult formation class will continue the lectionary based program Living the Good News. Fr. Wallace Ohl will continue to lead this class. The class will continue to meet in the room next to the youth room.

Since we have had so many celebration meals (isn't that great!), the formation team opted for a quieter start of Sunday school. On September 11, children, youth, and adults will meet in their respective classrooms. Each class will have a special opening day treat to eat to nourish their bodies as the formation classes begin (or continue) to nourish their souls. Children and youth will have games and activities to help kick off the new year. This is also an opportunity for parents to meet and get know their children's teachers.

Ministry Fair September 18

This year on September 18th, St. Michael's will be holding a Ministry Fair. We are excited about the arrival of Fr. Jason as our new priest, and we want to share that excitement with others. We want people (our long-time members, newcomers, and visitors) to know that there's more going on at St. Michael's than just two services on a Sunday morning, with a nursery.
